VANCOUVER GIRLS' SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION
INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT RULES
REVISED 01/06/11

- 1) Rain-out number: (360) 699-0664, select menu item #1 (in the event of inclement weather).
- 2) NO TEAM WILL BE ALLOWED TO PLAY WITHOUT HAVING SUBMITTED CONFIRMATION OF ASA REGISTRATION (EITHER A SIGNED ASA ROSTER OR ID CARDS) TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR PRIOR TO PLAYING THEIR FIRST GAME.
- 3) ASA Playing rules apply except where modified by these tournament rules.
- 4) Teams may elect to bat their rosters in pool play. Umpire must be notified at the pre-game meeting. When batting your roster, remember you cannot have a Courtesy Runner. By definition a Courtesy Runner is someone yet to be active in the game. Since all players are batting (involved), you cannot have a CR.
- 5) Five (5) runs per at bat will be in effect throughout the entire tournament.
- 6) Seeding for the 2nd & 3rd rounds will be determined by: a) wins-losses, b) head to head, c) runs allowed, d) runs scored, & e) coin flip, in that order.
(This does not apply to the 6GG tournament format. No seeding required.)
(Seeding not necessary in self-seeding brackets)
- 7) No new inning shall begin after 1 hour 30 minute time limit. If the game is tied at the end of the time limit or 7 innings, the tie breaker procedure will begin immediately.
- 8) No infield warm up between games. No warm up on the dirt behind bases until the Field Crew is finished.
- 9) The plate umpire will report scores to the Tournament Director at the completion of each game. Each team is responsible for checking the Bracket Board (posted on the side of the concession stand). All scores will become official one hour after the completion of the game.
- 10) No hitting or throwing anything into any of the fencing at the complex. Penalty = disqualification
- 11) No jumping or hopping over any of the fences. Penalty = disqualification
- 12) Any player or any person under 18 years of age **MUST** wear an approved catcher's mask when warming up a pitcher. Penalty = disqualification
- 13) Home team will be determined by a coin flip with the umpire at the pre-game conference. The team listed on the top of the bracket will occupy the first base dugout unless you have back-to-back games or if the coaches agree prior to the game on different dugouts.
- 14) All protests must be resolved prior to the next pitch and will be handled on the field at the time of the protest by the Tournament UIC and/or the Tournament Director.
- 15) Any player, coach or spectator ejected from any ball game will miss the remainder of that game AND shall be excluded from the team's next game.
- 16) Any illegal equipment removed from a game shall be kept in the clubhouse until the team has completed their participation in the tournament. (Unless the equipment is repairable.)

From I-5 Southbound, take the I-205/134th Street exit. Be sure to stay in the right hand lane as it will be the very first exit you come to. Go straight through the traffic light at 134th St (there will be a Burger King on the corner). Continue South merging with 20th Ave. until you go down a hill, there is a boat sales/storage place on your right at the traffic light - this is 117th Street. Turn right, go west for about 1/4 to 1/2 mile on 117th Street and watch for the entrance to our complex. There will be a white sign on the right (north) saying SALMON CREEK SPORTS COMPLEX - HOME OF THE VANCOUVER GIRLS' SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION. Go down the driveway and pull into the parking lot.

From I-5 Northbound, take the 99th Street exit and turn right (east). Go to the traffic light at old Hwy 99 (there is a 7-11 store on the left). Turn left (north) onto old Hwy 99, get into the left hand lane and continue north until you go down a hill (there is a traffic light about 2/3 down the hill and another at the bottom). At the bottom of the hill is a traffic light at 117th Street. Turn left (west) here. Continue westbound on 117th Street about 1/4 to 1/2 mile and watch for the entrance to our complex. There will be a white sign on the right (north) saying SALMON CREEK SPORTS COMPLEX - HOME OF THE VANCOUVER GIRLS' SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION. Go down the driveway and pull into the parking lot.

From I-205 Northbound, take the 20th Avenue/134th Street exit. At the traffic light, turn left (west) and go to 20th Avenue (traffic light) and turn left again (south) - there will be a Burgerville on the corner. Continue southbound, road turn into Hwy 99. You will go down a hill. At the bottom of the hill, there is a traffic light, this is 117th Street. Turn right, go west for about 1/4 to 1/2 mile on 117th Street and watch for the entrance to our complex. There will be a white sign on the right (north) saying SALMON CREEK SPORTS COMPLEX - HOME OF THE VANCOUVER GIRLS' SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION. Go down the driveway and pull into the parking lot.

From 134th Street exit, come south on old Hwy 99 past the McDonalds turn west at the traffic light onto 117th St

Exit on 99th Street, go east to traffic light, turn north and stay on old Hwy 99 until at the bottom of a hill, turn west at the traffic light onto 117th St
